PREAMBLE

At the time of its inception in 2001, the college offered 3 courses namely B.E ECE, CSE, and B.Tech IT. In 2005 B.E in EEE and in the year 2009 B.E in Mechanical and Civil was started. In 2011, a PG course named M.E in Applied Electronics was started. Along the way in 2013, ME courses in Computer Science and Engineering (CSE), Power Electronics and Drives (PED), and in 2014, M.E in Manufacturing Engineering (ME) and Construction Engineering and Management (CEM) were introduced. There has been a steady growth in intake right since its inception, and a spectacular improvement is being witnessed.

To summarize, this day the college offers 6 UG courses and 5 PG courses in Engineering and we further assure the society that more courses will be introduced in the future to show our gratitude and inclination to serve the general public with all earnestness, for all your invaluable support and faith you have reposed in us thus far.

In total, the college as of date has a student strength of 836.

Books are the source of information, knowledge, and wisdom and they are the mirrors of the world. In helping the students in their pursuit of acquiring greater knowledge, our college library presently has a collection of 3501 titles, 26879 volumes, 30 journals and 126 e-journals (DELNET), and– 2 newspapers.

The faculty members are the backbone of any institution. Their roles and responsibilities are very much closely tied to the central functions of higher education, our college management has understood this fully, and they have been acting very positively in fulfilling this requirement. Our college has faculty strength of 124, of which 98 are teaching faculty, 16 are technical and 10 are supporting staff. Out of 98 teaching faculties, 19 have completed a Ph.D. and 10 are pursuing their research. The college proposes to further expand our research activities by inducting more PhDs into its faculty.

Our management has been striving hard to develop a center of excellence in every department and with 5 PG departments; the college research has been given a fillip in the way of establishing the Entrepreneurship Development Cell.

To help slow learners, we conduct remedial classes and special computer training courses. For students to understand subtle nuances of subject materials, Bloom's taxonomy is followed which categorizes thinking skills ranging from recalling information, the most basic skill, to evaluation, which involves judging and stating an opinion about the information.

PLACEMENTS

The institution recorded a 62% placement rate, with 89 out of 143 students successfully placed in reputed companies through campus recruitment initiatives.
